
A major market town right at the heart of England with a wealth of opportunities and amenities both here and near.

Charlotte Inkle

Friends of Bellamy

On a mission to raise spirits during the pandemic, Charlotte Inkle and some friends decorated their local Bellamy Estate for Christmas.

When neighbours heard, they pitched in – raising more than £700 to install lights in trees across the estate. Not long after, the Friends of Bellamy group was born, with Charlotte as its chair.

Today, the group runs bingo nights, Easter and Halloween parties, and even subsidises panto tickets at Mansfield's Palace Theatre for local families – complete with goodie bags to keep costs down.

West Nottinghamshire College is a leading further education facility for under 19s and adults.

With four vibrant campuses in Mansfield, it welcomes more than 11,000 full and part-time students each year, offering a wide range of courses, apprenticeships and professional qualifications to kickstart career development.

The college is also home to the new Future Tech Skills and Knowledge Exchange – a cutting-edge skills centre equipped with industry-standard facilities to support hands-on STEM training.

To postgraduate...

The Nottingham Trent University (NTU) Vision West Notts Hub is part of a University ranked first in the UK by its students for employability and holding TEF Gold for teaching.

It's home to nearly 600 students on career-focused higher education courses from engineering to nursing. So, it's no surprise NTU's Mansfield campus is a leading choice for young people from our region and beyond.

After studying a Higher National Diploma (HND) at Vision West Notts College, Gabriel Johnson didn't have to travel far to find his dream job as a motion graphics designer at world-leading marketing agency Linney Create.

"I studied for four years at West Notts, which gave me a strong foundation and was a great stepping stone into the creative industry.

"After freelancing for Linney for a while, I officially joined its Film and Animation team 11 years ago. There have been other opportunities along the way, but I've stuck around because of the amazing team – a group of passionate storytellers dedicated to

bringing people together through the screen. It's been incredible to watch the team grow and be supported to grow and develop. I'm now a motion director, which means I get to work on films for household names like McDonald's, Starbucks and Royal Mail.



In 2022, more than 425 startups in Mansfield remained in business after 12 months of trading – the highest figure in the country.

With a central location, great-value land, and room to grow, Mansfield is a prime base for ambitious businesses – from international firms and experienced entrepreneurs to local SMEs and start-ups ready to scale.

We've got a wide range of dedicated business parks with direct connections to skills suppliers and key transport networks.

Crown Farm Industrial Estate, located less than 10 miles from the M1, is home to major firms including Toray Textiles, Crown Packaging, Plastek Limited and SPS Aerostructures.

The Mansfield Connect project will breathe new life into the historic Beales department store, transforming it into a vibrant multi-agency community hub that will bring new services, opportunities and investment into our town centre.

Linney Group


Nick Linney



Family owned and run, Linney is one of the most well-known business success stories – not just in Mansfield, but across the East Midlands.

What began as a bookshop in 1851 is today a major marketing services business that invests heavily in people and technology to support the work it does for some of the biggest brands in the world – ranging from insight-driven creative design to a fulfilment warehouse where state-of-the-art robots collect orders to be sent to customers.

Linney is Mansfield's largest private sector employer, with more than 1,000 people working across its vast Adamsway site. Self-described as 'restless since 1851', Linney's dedication to innovation continues to attract fresh talent and investment.



CASE STUDY:

Toffee Hut

Rachel Richards



Born and bred in Mansfield, Rachel Richards embodies our town's creative and entrepreneurial spirit.

After a 20-year career in social care, Rachel wanted to start afresh and launched Toffee Hut as an online business in 2019. Within the first few months, her website attracted wholesale orders and interest from big names including Harrods. Rachel made the leap to open her first high-street sweet shop and café in Mansfield in April 2021. The business sells toffees, fudge, peanut brittle and lollies, as well as coffee from local suppliers.

A second permanent Toffee Hut has since opened in Mansfield's Four Seasons Shopping Centre, bringing shoppers sweet treats and winning several business awards.

Just next-door is the **Mansfield Museum**, which celebrates our town's story and rich industrial heritage.




